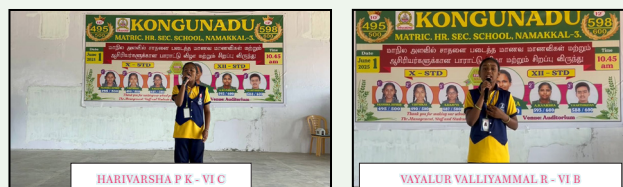

## தமிழ்நாடு நாள் (01 NOVEMBER 2025 )

தமிழ்நாடு நாள் என்பது தமிழருக்கென்று தனித் தாயகம் அல்லது மாநிலம் உருவான நாளைக் குறிப்பிடும் நாளாகும். இந்திய விடுதலைக்குப் பிறகு மொழி வாரியாக மாநிலங்கள் பிரிக்கப்படவேண்டும் என்ற கோரிக்கை வலுவடைந்திருந்தது. இதனால் இந்திய அரசு நவம்பர் -1,1956 இந்தியாவை மொழி வாரி மாநிலங்களாக பிரித்தது. மற்ற மாநிலங்களுக்கு எல்லாம் அவர்கள் விரும்பிய பெயர் அந்தந்த மாநிலங்களுக்கு சூட்டப்பட்டது. ஆனால் தமிழ்நாட்டிற்கு மட்டும் மதராஸ் என்ற பழைய பெயரே மாற்றம் இன்றி தொடரும் என்றானது. ஆனால் தமிழ்நாடு என்ற பெயர் சூட்ட வேண்டும் என்ற கோரிக்கைகளும் போராட்டங்களும் தொடர்ந்து தமிழகத்தில் நடந்தது. மெட்ராஸ் என்ற மாகாணத்தை தமிழ்நாடு என பெயர் சூட்ட வேண்டும் என வலியுறுத்தி விருதுநகரைச் சேர்ந்த சங்கரலிங்கனார் உண்ணாவிரதம் இருந்து 1956 அக்டோபர் 13ஆம் தேதி அன்று தன் இன்னுயிரை நீத்தார் அவருடைய தியாகத்தை தொடர்ந்து மக்களிடையே தமிழ்நாடு என்ற பெயருக்கு ஆதரவு அதிகமாக இருந்தது. பிறகு அறிஞர் அண்ணா முதலமைச்சராக இருந்தபோது அவரது தலைமையிலான அரசு 1967ஆம் ஆண்டு ஜூலை 18 ஆம் தேதி தமிழ்நாடு என பெயர் மாற்ற தீர்மானத்தை ஒரு மனதாக நிறைவேற்றியது. அதைத்தொடர்ந்து 1969 ஜனவரி 14 ல் மெட்ராஸ் ஸ்டேட் என்பது தமிழ்நாடு என அதிகாரப்பூர்வமாக பெயர் மாற்றம் செய்யப்பட்டது. தமிழ்நாடு என்ற மாநிலம் உருவாவதற்கு ஒரு நீண்ட நெடிய போராட்டமும் சில உயிரிழப்புகளும் தியாகங்களும் தேவைப்பட்டன என்பதே வரலாறு நமக்கு சொல்லும் உண்மையாகும்.

# NATIONAL INTEGRATION DAY (19 NOVEMBER 2025)

National Integration Day is observed every year on November 19 to mark the birth anniversary of Indira Gandhi, the first woman prime minister of India. National Integration Day was officially introduced by the Indian National Congress in 1985 to commemorate Indira Gandhi's invaluable contribution to India's unity. The observance of this day holds deep significance as it highlights the importance of celebrating India's diversity while acknowledging the need to work together for the greater good of the Nation. India, with its rich cultural, linguistic, and religious diversity, has frequently faced challenges that test the limits of its unity during Indira Gandhi's term as prime minister, spanning from 1966 to 1977 and again from 1980 until her tragic assassination in 1984. She worked tirelessly to promote national integration.

One of the most controversial periods of her leadership was the emergency from 1975 to 1977, during which she reduced civil liberties in an attempt to maintain political stability. This period highlighted her belief that preserving National unity was essential for India's progress. 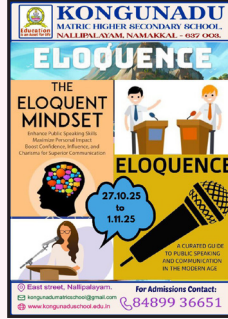

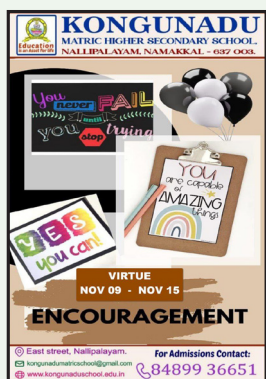

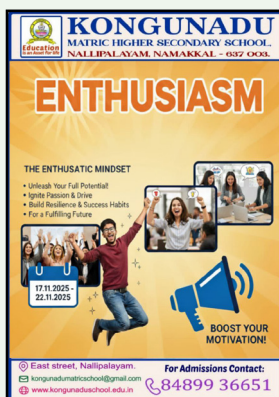
