மண்ணின் பயன் : தாவரத்திற்கு மண்ணில் இருந்து நைட்ரஜன், பாஸ்பரஸ், பொட்டாசியம், சுண்ணாம்பு, மக்னீசியம், கந்தகம், இரும்பு, மாங்கனீசு, தாமிரம், துத்தநாகம், குளோரின் போன்ற சத்துக்கள் தாவரங்களுக்கு மண்ணில் இருந்து கிடைக்கிறது. ஒரு பயிர் விளைந்த பின் வேறு ஒரு பயிரை பயிரிடுவதன் மூலம் மண்ணின் ஊட்டச்சத்துக்களை புதுப்பிக்கலாம். இம்முறைகளை கடைப்பிடிப்பதன் மூலம் மண்ணைப் பாதுகாக்கலாம்.
